Horticultural Sustainable Development Strategy (HSDS)

Scoping Study Findings Paper – Public Exhibition

As part of a Scoping Study being prepared for a future strategy to deliver sustainable horticultural development in the Mildura Older Irrigated Areas (MOIA), a Findings Paper has been released by Council for formal public comment.

During the process of Council's deliberations regarding the MOIA issues in Amendment C89, Council separately resolved to prepare a detailed scoping study to guide preparation of a subsequent strategy to consider economic, social and environmental drivers beyond the scope of the amendment.

The aim is to capitalise on the infrastructure investment arising from the Sunraysia Modernisation Project and enable formulation of options to deliver sustainable horticultural development within the MOIA.

The Scoping Study is to assist engagement of relevant stakeholders and ensure all issues are garnered before confirming a possible way forward. It is therefore important that all relevant matters are raised in this study and the appropriate focus areas identified for the HSDS further work.

A findings paper has been prepared to obtain feedback on both the matters raised and suggested focus areas and is now open for public comment until Friday 11 August 2017.
