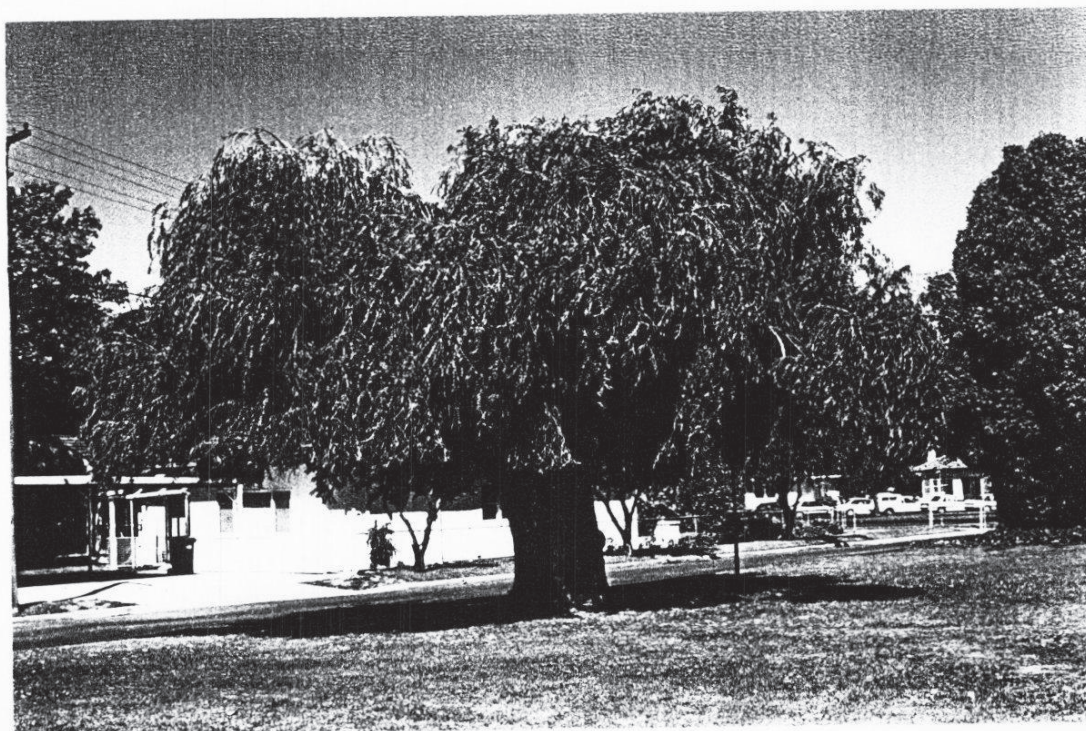

REMEDIAL ACTION- Prepare maintenance program, monitor annually. Prepare technical aboricultural program for pruning and general tree management.
COMMENTS- The region has a number of Sugar Gums, and a consistent row in a road centre is significant, however general pruning of Deakin Ave trees has destroyed their value. Retaining a significant group in the event of a decision to remove all others should be considered.

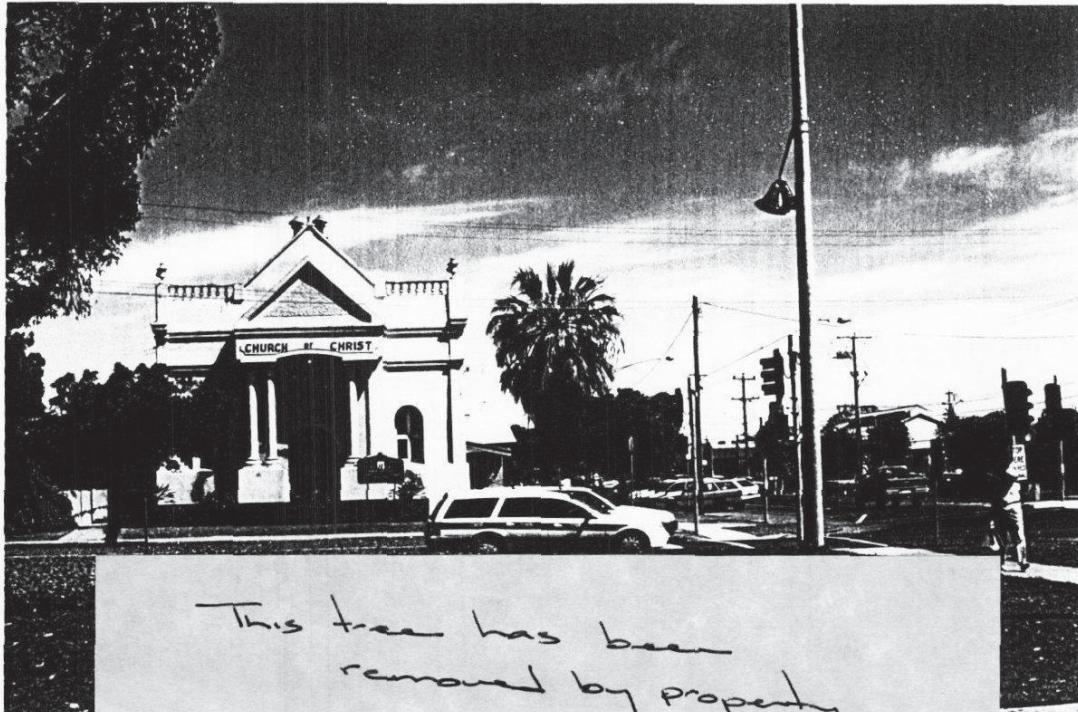

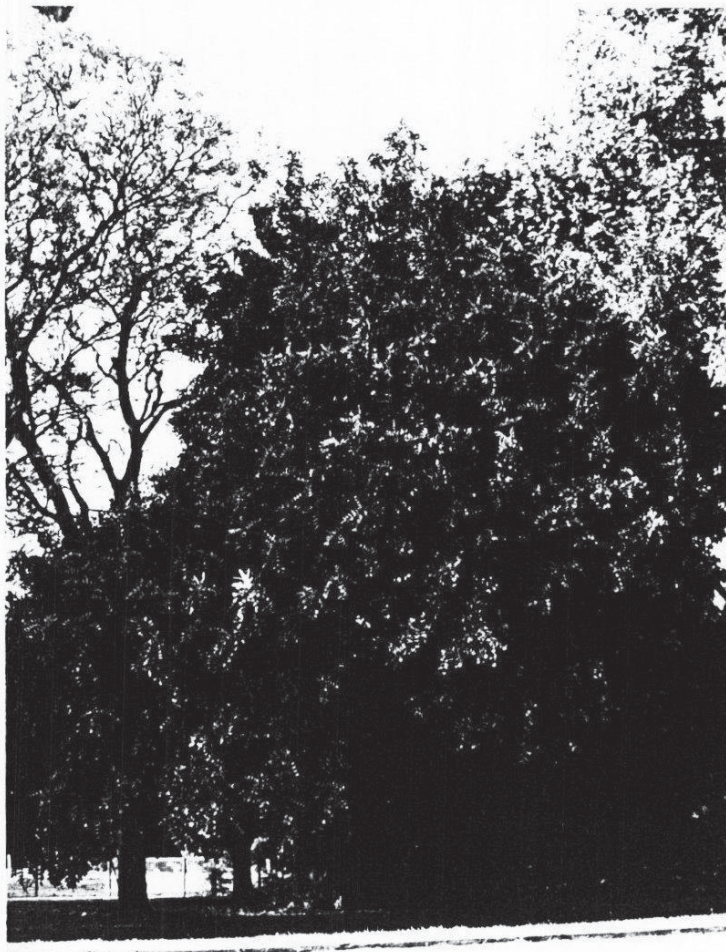
