Detox your Home is a free service for Victorian householders to safely dispose of toxic chemicals.

Free, regular pop-up events are available across Victoria where toxic household chemicals can be safely disposed of.

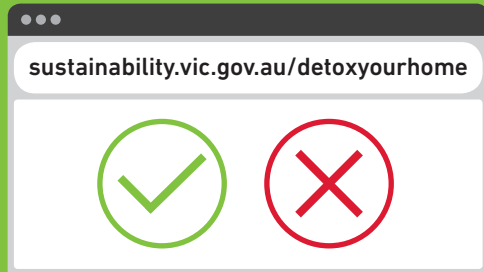
Detox your Home. It's easy and it's free.

What to do and where to go depends on what you want to dispose of – and you can do it in just three easy steps:

Step 1: Identify what chemicals and products you want to dispose of



Step 2: Check our website to find out what items are accepted



Step 3: Find your nearest pop-up event on our website



For items like pesticides, weed killers, detergents, pool chemicals, car wax and fuels

Unwanted or out-of-date, highly toxic chemicals can be taken to a free Detox your Home pop-up event.

We have chemists on hand to collect and safely dispose of these items.

For safety reasons we can't accept containers larger than 20 litres or 20 kilograms or return the containers to you.

Please bring your chemicals in non-returnable containers.

Disposing of chemicals responsibly reduces the risk of poisoning, keeping your family and pets safe. It also keeps chemicals out of waterways, minimises environmental pollution, and fire hazards.
