4.	<p><b>Proposed Kerbside Food Organics, Garden Organics Service (FOGO)</b></p> <p>Overview of consultation and proposed service discussed. Aiming for approval at September 2018 Council Meeting.</p> <p>Information will be communicated at various community meetings and information stalls at local Markets throughout May &amp; June.</p> <p>Proposed kerbside collection to be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- 120L Waste Bin – Fortnightly Collection (alternate with FOGO bin service)</li><li>- 240L Recycle Bin – Stay as Fortnightly Collection</li><li>- 240L FOGO Bin – Weekly Collection</li></ul> <p>Aim is to remove the organics material that is in the rubbish bins out from going to landfill. This will decrease the potential for pollution from greenhouse gas and leachate.</p>	Sarah O'Connor	
5.	<p><b>General Business</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Sean mentioned back quarter (batters area be cleaned up) – EPA have also noted this and it is currently underway.</li><li>• Gas and Groundwater Monitoring Services Contract – Currently being evaluated.</li><li>• Concrete pile needs to be crushed. EPA have requested that MRCC crush/manage current concrete stockpile. We are also reviewing the acceptance on concrete going forward to manage our stockpiles and not wanting to crush on-site anymore.</li></ul> <p>Nearby residents to be notified when this will happen, duration of time needed to complete this once-off onsite crushing of concrete. The normal dust management will be applied while crushing.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Nick advised there may be some complaints coming through due to some dust/mulching onsite.</li></ul>	All
