Council to investigate transition from Aged & Disability Services

Council is undertaking a consultation process with a view to transition out of aged and disability service delivery.

The move follows a recent in-principle decision and follows significant aged care industry reforms, which will see Council's current contracts to deliver services on behalf of the Commonwealth Government end in June 2023.

The Commonwealth's impending end to current Aged Care programs, and transition to a new model of care, has triggered a need for Council to determine if it is in the best interests of the community to continue as a provider of aged care services.

Should a decision be made to exit out of Aged Care services, Council will then work closely with the State and Commonwealth Governments – and new providers – to ensure a smooth transition for staff and clients.

Groups proposing projects on Council owned or managed facilities must apply for, and receive, approved Land Manager's Consent prior to submitting a grant application. Groups requiring Land Manager's Consent are encouraged to contact Council prior to starting a grant application as the approval process may take up to six weeks to complete.

The Committee pursues Best Practice Guidelines for Audit and Risk Committees and internal audit. Council is committed to establishing and supporting the primary objectives of the Committee.

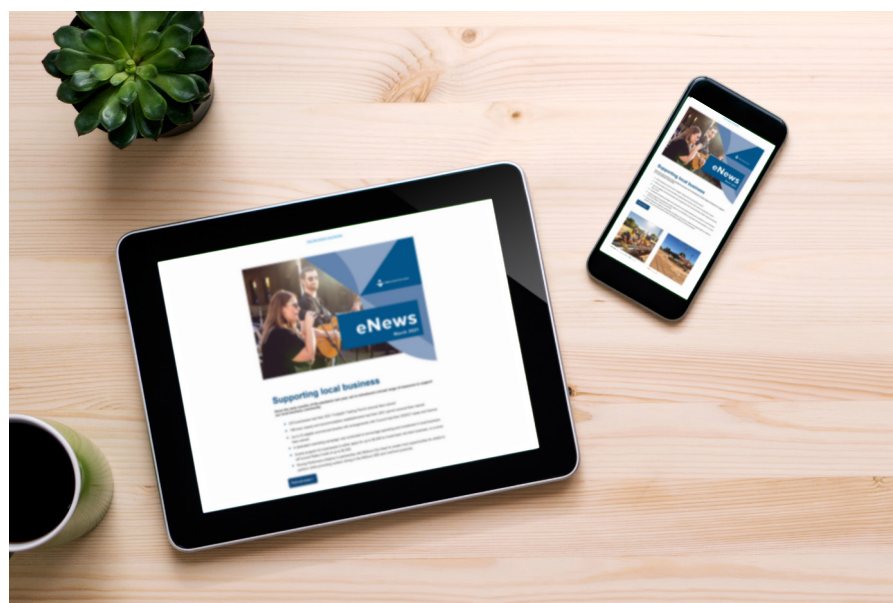
The Committee meets bi-monthly and all members are required to sign a Confidentiality Agreement.
