Update of Governance Rules
Council is committed to working with the community to improve public confidence in the decisions it makes, and to ensuring decisions reflect the best interest of all sections of our community.

To facilitate transparency in Council decision making processes, Governance Rules are in place which enable Council to:

- Consider and make decisions on any matter being considered by the Council fairly and on their merits; and

- Institute decision making processes to ensure that any person whose rights will be directly affected by a decision of the Council is entitled to communicate their views and have their interests considered.

These Governance Rules have been in place since September 2020 and have recently been updated to align with best practice. Council is undertaking a process of community engagement and hereby invites public submissions on the updates which include: addition of Governance Framework; Re-wording of Election of Mayor, Addition of Declaration of Conflicts of Interest in Order of Business, Widening of Councillor Reports; Appropriate provisions for Councillor Questions.

Recreation Assistance

The newly re-vamped Recreation Assistance Grant Program now offers additional programs offering funding of up to \$50,000 for major facility upgrades, up to \$13,000 for recreation planning projects and up to \$3,000 in quick response club support grants.

Potential Recreation Assistance applicants must contact Council to discuss their application prior to submission.

Groups proposing projects on Council owned or managed facilities must apply for, and receive, approved Land Manager's Consent prior to submitting a grant application. Groups requiring Land Manager's Consent are encouraged to contact Council prior to starting a grant application as the approval process may take up to six weeks to complete.

Events Funding and Support

The Events Funding and Support Grant Program is once again offering up to \$50,000 for Hallmark Events, up to \$20,000 for Major Events and up to \$5,000 for Community Events.
