Proposed Budget for 2022-23

Mildura Rural City Council seeks community feedback on the Draft 2022-23 Budget prepared for the purposes of Section 94 of the Local Government Act 2020.

The Draft Budget relates to the Financial Year commencing on 1 July 2022, and:

- The proposed budget is prepared on the basis of the application of the average base rate will rise by 1.75% in line with the order by the Minister for Local Government in accordance with the Fair Go Rates System (FGRS).
- Details of the objectives of each differential rate, the types of classes of land that are subject to each differential rate and the uses of each differential rate are set out in Council's Rating Strategy 2019-2023, which is available for viewing on the Council's website.
- A detailed listing of statutory fees can be obtained from the Fees and Charges Schedule 2022-23, which can be viewed

on Council's website.

- Discloses that, as at 30 June 2022, that the total amount borrowed by Council will be \$14.298 million.
- Proposes that the total amount to be redeemed during the Financial Year is projected to be \$1.554 million.
- Proposes that, as at 30 June 2023, the total amount of new borrowings by Council is projected to be \$9.25 million.
- Proposes that, as at 30 June 2023, the total amount borrowed by Council is projected to be \$21.994 million.
- Proposes that the cost of servicing the borrowing during the Financial Year is projected to be \$0.944 million.
