Expanded JE vaccination eligibility criteria* Victoria's priority groups eligible for funded JE vaccine will now include:

- People who reside or usual place of work in the following local government areas of Campaspe, Gannawarra, Greater Shepparton, Indigo, Loddon, Mildura, Moira, Swan Hill, Wodonga and Towong and who meet the following criteria:
- Aged 50 years or above and
- Spend at least 4 hours per day outdoor (occupational or recreational)
