Kings of Leon information

Heading to the Kings of Leon concert this Saturday 29 October? Here's what you need to know!

- Gates open at 4:30pm, with The Temper Trap performing from 7:15pm to 8pm before Kings of Leon take the stage from 8:30pm to 10:30pm.
- Free bus shuttles will be operating from several locations to safely transport attendees to and from the concert. If you are catching a shuttle from an outlying region, please register at <https://www.trybooking.com/CDTXT> to ensure sufficient shuttles available. If you are catching a shuttle from any of the Mildura locations, there is no need to register. Shuttles will be running every 15 minutes from 5pm from Aerodrome Ovals, The Gateway Tavern, Mildura Recreation Reserve, Nowingi Place and at bus stops along Deakin Avenue, Ontario Avenue and Etiwanda Avenue. Other shuttles will operate from 5pm, as required, from Quandong Park, Red Cliffs, Irymple Secondary College, Kenny Park, Merbein, Buronga, the bus stop at the Gol Gol Hotel, Coomealla Club, Dareton, and Beverly Street (the swimming pool), Wentworth. Return shuttles will be running after the event. Please return to where the shuttle dropped you off.
- Deakin Avenue between Sixteenth and Seventeenth Streets and Sixteenth Street between Deakin and San Mateo Avenues will be closed from 4pm to midnight on the day of the concert except to local traffic.

- A temporary campground will be open from Thursday 27 October to Tuesday 1 November at the Mildura Recreation Reserve (No. 3 Oval) to provide an option for visitors whose accommodation has been affected by rising river levels or any last-minute bookings. Campers must register and accept conditions at www.mildura.vic.gov.au/temporarycampground This campground will be self-managed, with toilets and showers available. There are 130, 6x8m camp sites available.

Japanese Encephalitis Vaccine Clinic

The Japanese encephalitis (JE) vaccine is available to:

- people who are over 50, spend a significant amount of time outdoors (more than four hours a day) and you live or work in one of the local government areas of Campaspe, Gannawarra, Greater Shepparton, Indigo, Loddon, Mildura, Moira, Swan Hill, Wodonga and Towong.
- people who work at, reside at, or have a planned non-deferable visit to a:
 - piggery, including but not limited to farm workers and their families (including children aged 2 months and older) living at the piggery, transport workers, veterinarians and others involved in the care of pigs
 - property that has been confirmed to be infected with JE virus
 - property suspected to be infected with JE virus
 - pork abattoir or pork rendering plant.
 - personnel who work directly with mosquitoes through their surveillance (field or laboratory based) or control and management, and indirectly through management of vertebrate mosquito-borne disease surveillance systems (e.g. sentinel animals) such as:
 - environmental health officers and workers (urban and remote)
 - entomologists

- all diagnostic and research laboratory workers who may be exposed to the virus, such as persons working with JE virus cultures or mosquitoes with the potential to transmit JE virus; as per the Australian Immunisation Handbook.
