### Notice of Intention to Amend a Local Law

Local Law No. 2 (Community Local Law 2)

Pursuant to section 73 of the Local Government Act 2020, Mildura Rural City Council gives notice regarding its intention to amend Local Law No.2 (Community Local Law) and to invite public submissions in accordance with Section 223 of the Local Government Act 1989.

The purpose of the Local Law is to:

- Ensure the peace, order and good government of the municipality. It relates to a wide variety of issues including use of public reserves, consumption of alcohol in public places, use of streets, roads and footpaths and Council land, keeping of animals, control and regulation of emissions to the air, burning off and disposal of rubbish.

Repeal Local Law No. 2 (Community Local Law) last adopted on 27 April 2017.
