Notice of Intention to Amend a Local Law

Local Law No. 5 - Protection of Council Assets and Control of Building Sites Pursuant to section 73 of the Local Government Act 2020, Mildura Rural City Council gives notice regarding its intention to amend Local Law No.5 (Protection of Council Assets and Control of Building Sites) and to invite public submissions in accordance with Section 223 of the Local Government Act 1989.

The purpose of the Local Law is to:

- Ensure the peace, order and good government of the municipality. It relates to a wide variety of issues including protection of Council assets on road reserve, stormwater protection, use of streets, roads and footpaths and containment, removal and disposal of builder's refuse.

The majority of proposed changes were administrative in nature ensuring appropriate use of language throughout the document to be consistent and to avoid confusion

such as removing duplication with State Legislation, simplification of wording, clarification when considering permits and review of definitions.

Any person may lodge a formal written submission to the Chief Executive Officer at Mildura Rural City Council, PO Box 105 Mildura VIC 3502 or via email to mrcc@mildura.vic.gov.au by close of business on Friday 2 December 2022.

Any person may request, as part of their submission, to appear in person, or for a representative acting on their behalf who is specified in the submission to appear before a meeting of Council or a Council committee.

Changes to bin collection days

- Between Eleventh Street, Benetook Avenue, Cureton Avenue East and Cowra Avenue

Have your say on Draft Merbein Pedestrian and Cycling Plan

Feedback is now being sought on the Draft Merbein Pedestrian and Cycling Plan.

The plan aims to address pedestrian and cycling issues identified by the community following surveys and in-person consultation sessions in May 2022.

The objectives of the Pedestrian and Cycling Plan include:

- Provision of additional pedestrian and cycling facilities,
- Improvements to existing pedestrian and cycling facilities,
- Provision of safer crossing facilities for pedestrians and cyclists,
- Provision of better walking and cycling links, and
- Reduce the occurrence and potential for vehicle and pedestrian/cyclist crashes.
- The recommendations aim to address missing walking and cycling links within Merbein, improve connectivity to key destinations as well as provision of safer crossing locations, and include:
- Provision of an east-west and north-south bicycle connection through Merbein
- Provision of footpaths on roads leading to the main shopping precinct as well as schools and parks
- Provision of crossing locations to enable safer crossing facilities

- Provision of shared user paths to provide off-road facilities for connections to schools

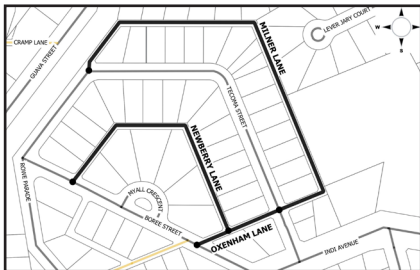

Geographic Naming Proposals

Red Cliffs Laneways

Council is proposing to name three laneways in Red Cliffs, including:

- Milner Lane
- Newberry Lane
- Oxenham Lane



Bryan Milner was a founding member of the Red Cliffs Lions Club in 1968. He was one of only two founding members remaining at the time of his passing in 2022. Bryan was a local electrician and in 1965 he had the job of lighting and maintaining a kerosene beacon on top of the Yatpool Television Tower. He would climb the 500-foot tower twice a week for approximately three months, before replacing it with an electric beacon.

Archibald and Elsie Newberry were both born in 1893 and arrived in Red Cliffs in 1922 when it was a tent town. "Arch" worked in the gangs that were preparing the land for settlement. His interest in radio eventuated in his business, Radio House and he and Elsie began the first radio station to broadcast in Sunraysia (3AN). Elsie was an announcer, a 'trailblazer' at a time when only men were considered announcers. Arch also served in the RAAF in WWII, he died in 1973 aged 79. Elsie died in 1970 aged 76.

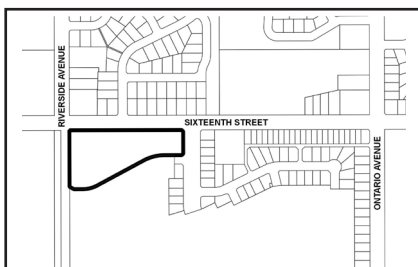
Samuel Oxenham was born in 1871, he was a soldier settler and was known locally for his vegetable growing. He had a large family of nine children, with twins David and Mary born in 1907 being the eldest. Mary never married and became a grower in her own right. She was known in the community for her hard work and kindness, particularly to children, and skills at needlecraft. She passed away in 2010, aged 103. David served in WWII, along with brothers, Samuel 'Lloyd' Oxenham 1912-1984, and Reginald 'Jack' Oxenham 1915-1943. Jack died as a POW at Changi Prison. David died aged 65 in 1972.
