Mildura Urban Forest Strategy

Council recently commenced working with Mesh Planning to prepare a Mildura Urban Forest Strategy. The term 'Urban Forest' refers to all trees and shrubs present in an area, which provide long-term community benefits, such as cooler and more attractive streets.

The aim of Mildura's Urban Forest Strategy is to expand tree canopy coverage in public spaces such as streets and parks across our main city and smaller townships. Other forms of greening can also be incorporated into the strategy following further analysis and what we learn from the community.

We want to hear your thoughts on your experiences with street trees and parks, what the issues and opportunities are, relating to expanding shade and tree cover across Mildura's urban areas.

Your comments will inform the next stage of the project, where we will define a vision and strategies to create and expand the overall Urban Forest coverage.

Domestic Animal Act 1994 ORDER UNDER SECTION 26(2)

Pursuant to and in accordance with section 26(2) of the Domestic Animals Act 1994, Council makes the following Order:

1. Revocation of previous orders

Council revokes all previous orders made under section 26(2) of the Domestic Animals Act 1994.

2. Dogs and cats must be under effective control

The Owner of any dog or cat must keep the dog or cat under effective control by means of a chain, cord or leash (not exceeding 2 metres in length) while the dog or cat is in any of the following public places:

- 2.1 all Roads within Urban Areas;
- 2.2 Apex Park Beach;
- 2.3 all Public Reserves, except those which are Designated Off Leash Areas;
- 2.4 Langtree Mall; and
- 2.5 within 10 metres of any playground equipment.

**3. Designated Off Leash Areas
The following areas are Designated Off Leash Areas:**

- 3.1 Mildura Off Leash Dog Park - Hugh King Drive Mildura

4. Owner's obligations in relation to off-leash dogs

If a dog is in a public place in which the Owner is not required to restrain the dog by a chain, cord or leash under this Order, the Owner must:

- 4.1 carry a chain, cord or leash sufficient to bring the dog under control by placing the dog on a chain, cord or leash if the dog behaves in a manner which threatens any person or animal;
- 4.2 remain in effective voice and or hand control of the dog and

within constant sight of the dog so as to be able to promptly bring the dog under control by placing the dog on a chain, cord or leash if that becomes necessary or desirable to avoid any wandering out of effective control or to avoid any threatening behaviour or any attack; and

- 4.3 not allow the dog to worry, rush at or otherwise threaten any person or animal, and must not allow the dog to attack any person or animal.

5. Meaning of words

In this Order:

5.1 Designated Off Leash Area means an area described in paragraph 3 of this Order;

5.2 Owner has the same meaning as in the Domestic Animals Act 1994;

5.3 Public Reserve means any Park, garden, lake, sporting or recreation ground or common owned by Council or under its management or control and includes any parking area, hall or other building located thereon;

5.4 Road has the same meaning as in the Local Government Act 1989.

5.5 Urban Area means any area that is in a:

- 5.5.1 Low Density Residential Zone;
- 5.5.2 Mixed Use Zone;
- 5.5.3 Township Zone;
- 5.5.4 Residential Growth Zone;
- 5.5.5 Neighbourhood Residential Zone;
- 5.5.6 Industrial Zone;
- 5.5.7 Commercial Zone;
- 5.5.8 Public Use Zone;
- 5.5.9 Special Use Zone;
- 5.5.10 Comprehensive Development Zone; or
- 5.5.11 Urban Floodway Zone, under the Planning Scheme.
