## **Welcome to our Libraries**

You can access a range of materials and online resources.

We have services, programs and community spaces for everyone.

## **Membership is free**

Visit any of our Libraries and bring current Victorian identification showing your name and residential address. Children and young people under 18 require a parent or legal guardian to join.

- Borrow up to 20 items with no late/overdue fees
- Your checkout receipt shows item date due
- Automatic renewals may occur once
- Receive notifications by email or SMS for holds or overdue items
- 24-hour return chutes at Mildura, Merbein, Red Cliffs and Ouyen
- Charges will apply for items that are lost or have been damaged
- A PIN will give you access to eLibrary and online resources
- Young people under 12 must be actively supervised in the library
- Please notify staff of any change of name, address or loss of membership card.

Memberships are available for neighbouring municipalities, visitors, eLibrary access, teachers and education providers, speak to staff for more information.



## **Borrowing**

Please bring your Library card, physical or digital, when borrowing.

You are responsible for the care and return of items borrowed on your card. Please report damaged or faulty items to staff.

We have books for all reading levels, available in regular, large print and books designed for dyslexic readers. Why not try graphic novels, audiobooks, DVDs, CDs, magazines, newspapers and eResources!

## eLibrary

Library apps can help you manage your library membership and to access our eLibrary.

You will need your email address, library card number and PIN to register. We recommend using a Wi-Fi network when downloading, data charges will apply using a cellular network. Visit our eLibrary webpage for more information.

Visit your app store or download to your device from our website to access books, audiobooks, graphic novels, magazines, newspapers, movies and documentaries.

## Download our apps from your app store



**BorrowBox** - eBooks  
and eAudiobooks

Library – search for Mildura Library and enter your User ID (Library card number) and PIN. Agree to the terms and conditions, provide an email address and your first name.



**Library Pass Comics Plus**  
- digital comics, graphic novels and manga

Tap “get started”. Search for ‘Mildura’ and choose ‘Full Library’ collection. Type in your library card number and tap login.



**uLIBRARY** - eAudiobooks

Library – search for Mildura Rural City Council Libraries and enter your Barcode Number (Library card number) and PIN and sign in. Accept terms and conditions, and select eAudiobooks to start browsing and listening. Choose the More option if you would like to enter your email address for notifications.



**cloudLibrary NewsStand** -  
magazines and newspapers

Tap ‘New User’ at bottom of the screen. Fill in the registration, accept the terms and tap Next. Choose your country and library (Mildura Rural City Council Libraries) from the drop-down menus, then tap Register. At the login screen type your library card number and PIN and tap Register.



**Kanopy** - Stream six films  
per month, “Kids” has  
unlimited views

Sign up with your name, email and a new password of six characters. Kanopy will send you an email. Open the email from Kanopy, click Verify Email. Search library name (Mildura) and enter your library card number.

## **Local and Family History**

Our local history collections include unique books, documents, newspapers and online images. View our local newspaper archive dating back to 1888 at Mildura Library using the microform reader/printer. Early local newspapers are also available on the Trove website.

For those interested in genealogy we have research materials and free access to Ancestry and Find My Past in our libraries.

## **Literacy Support**

## **Meeting Room Hire\***
