## TREE SELECTIONS

Mildura Rural City Council is creating healthier and greener neighbourhoods through its Cool It Street Program.

Several lucky neighbourhoods will undergo a transformation through the program, which aims to provide quality tree canopy cover by planting semi-mature trees in areas of need.



### Chinese Pistachio

*Pistacia Chinensis*

**Height: 7 metres**

**Width: 7 metres**

The Chinese Pistachio is round tree native to central and western China.

It is a moderately-growing deciduous variety that boasts vibrant shades of orange, yellow and red, while producing small white flowers following by red drupes.

It is drought-tolerant and thrives in most soil types.



### Euky Dwarf

*Eucalyptus Leucoxydon*

**Height: 6 metres**

**Width: 5 metres**

The Euky Dwarf is single trunk tree native to western Victoria, South Australia and south-western New South Wales.

It is a moderate to fast-growing tree that boast grey-green leaves and pink and red blossoms.

It is frost and full sun tolerant and is perfect to plant under powerlines.



### Hybrid Coral Gum

*Eucalyptus Torwood*


**Height: 6 to 8 metres**

**Width: 5 to 7 metres**

The Hybrid Coral Gum is a broad domed tree endemic to Western Australia.

Fast-growing, evergreen variety that develops blue-green foliage, while also producing large, orange, scarlet and yellow flowers in the spring and summer.

It is both frost and drought tolerant once established and prefers a low rainfall environment.



### Pin Cushion

*Hakea Laurina*

**Height: 3 to 5 metres**

**Width: 2 to 3 metres**

The Pin Cushion is a round, moderately growing tree native to south-western Australia.

Its leaves tend to wave and curl, and in from autumn to late winter it is known to produce cherry red, ball-like flowers.

It is drought tolerant and is also able to handle strong winds.



### Weeping Myall

*Acacia Pendula*

**Height: 6-8 metres**

**Width: 4-5 metres**

The Weeping Myall is a thick pendulous branching tree native to northern Victoria, NSW and southern Queensland.

It is a long-live variety of wattle tree that develops blue-grey foliage over time, while also producing small yellow flowers in summer and autumn.
