

CBD Access and Mobility Strategy

Following the recent adoption of the CBD Plan 2020-2035, Council has appointed the Institute of Sensible Transport to prepare a CBD Access and Mobility Strategy.

This project commenced in August 2020 and aims to improve access and mobility to and around the Mildura CBD. A key objective is to see more people choose to walk, cycle, or scooter into the CBD rather than drive.

Over the past 12 months Council has heard from the local community via online stakeholder workshops and surveys. Based on feedback provided, and detailed policy and data analysis investigating car park access and demand, a Draft Mildura CBD Access and Mobility Strategy has been prepared for public comment.


