What can be disposed of at your local Transfer Station?

Ouyen Landfill

Waste accepted: domestic waste.

Recycling accepted: cardboard, paper, polystyrene, plastics, glass bottles and jars, steel, aluminium, scrap metal, e-waste, tyres*, vehicle batteries, automotive oil, drumMUSTER, green waste and timber. Small amounts of concrete.

Cullulleraine Transfer Station

Murrayville Transfer Station

Nangiloc Transfer Station

Underbool Transfer Station

Walpeup Transfer Station (no automotive oil)

Werrimull Transfer Station

Waste accepted: domestic waste.

Recycling accepted: cardboard, paper, polystyrene, plastics, glass bottles and jars, steel, aluminium, scrap metal, e-waste, tyres*, vehicle batteries, automotive oil, drumMUSTER, green waste and timber.

*No tyres on rims.

No asbestos accepted at any of these sites.

SEPARATION CATEGORIES



Scrap Metal

Car bodies, iron, steel, wire and whitegoods.



Electrical Waste

Computer, TV's, stereo's, game consoles, printers, appliances and telephones.



Waste Oil

Clean, used or unwanted motor oil.



Concrete, bricks and rubble

Clean concrete, bricks and rubble.



Batteries

Car, truck and household batteries.



Green Waste

Lawn clippings, branches and garden prunings.



Cardboard & Paper

Cardboard boxes (please flatten) and all types of paper.



Timber

Posts, frames, doors.



Glass

Clean bottles and jars.



Polystyrene



Aluminium & Steel

Cans, clean foil trays and clean steel.



Clean and empty chemical drums (plastic and steel) with the drumMUSTER logo.



Rigid Plastics

Clean empty bottles, takeaway, containers and all plastic lids.



Tyres

No tyres on rims.



Household Waste

(not recyclable)

GET IT SORTED!

Get the most from your Transfer Station

Did you know that you can recycle a wide range of materials at transfer stations across the Region and in many cases you can drop some of these items off for free!

By taking a little extra time to sort your load before you leave home, you can save yourself plenty of time by easily disposing of the different materials at each of the transfer stations.

Sorting your load can also save you money.

Many items that are accepted at these facilities can be accepted for free, so recycling makes both environmental and economic sense.

But the real benefit of transfer stations is that they have collection points for many recyclable materials.

Sorting your load before you go to your transfer station helps recycle more materials and can be significantly cheaper than dumping all your materials in the rubbish.

*Don't forget to secure your load by either using a tarp, a net, tie down straps or rope.
