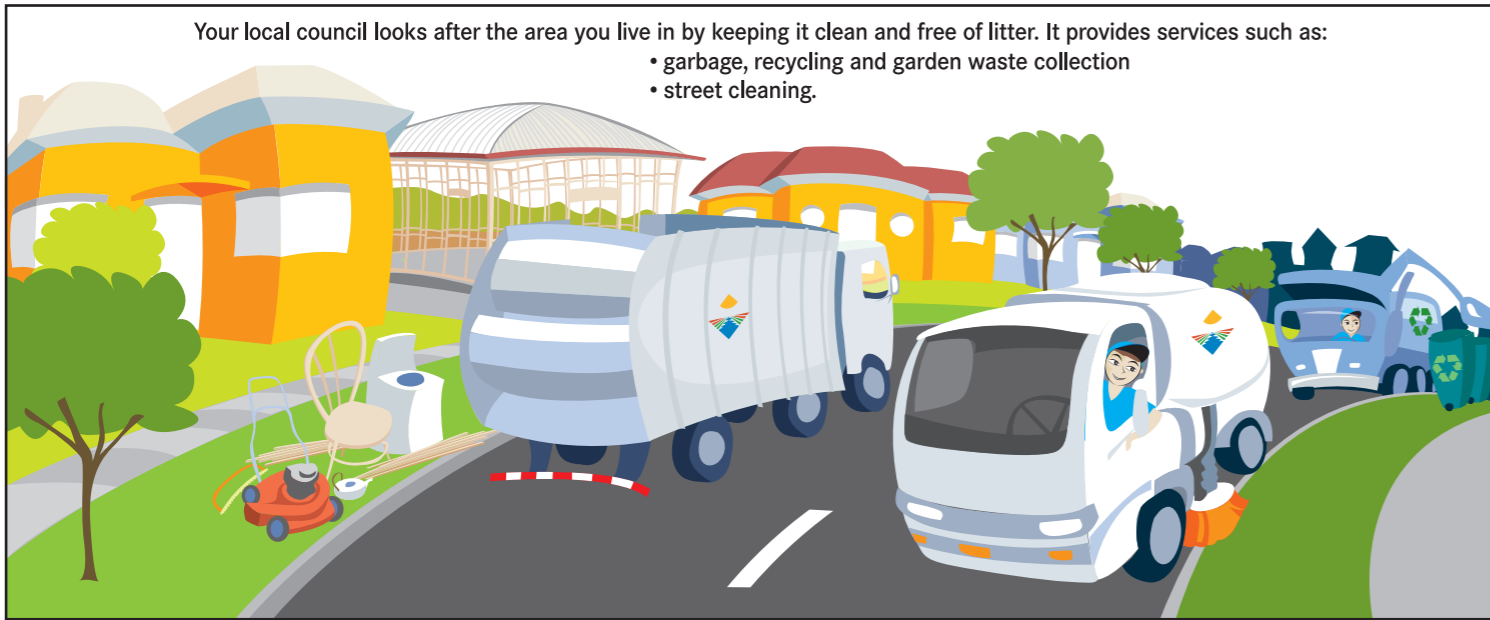


Waste and recycling
