Koorlong Playground and Park

Community consultation for a new playground in Koorlong at the intersection of Benetook Avenue and Twentieth Street has been completed, with concept designs out for tender.

It is anticipated the new playground construction will commence before the end of June 2023.

Buxton Sobee Playground and Equipment Replacement

New play equipment is set to be installed at Buxton Sobee Park.

Community consultation has commenced, with construction expected to be underway by the end of June 2023.



Shade will also be a high priority as part of the upgrade.

Annual Playground Shade Program

This project will supply and install roof shade structures to the Washington Park, Brodie Park, Hollywood Boulevard and Diablo Park Playgrounds.

The project will be completed by June 2023.

Region returning to normal following recordsetting flood

Slowly but surely our region is returning normal following the recent Murray River Flood event, which saw river levels reach heights not seen in our region for more than 70 years.

Mildura Rural City Council has spent the past few months steadily working through the task of assessing, cleaning up and rectifying flood-impacted roads and community assets.

It's been a massive task, with almost 60 Council-managed roads at one point impacted by flood water, stretching from the Nangiloc-Colignan area through to Lake Cullulleraine.

Hundreds of community assets such as public toilets, parks and other infrastructure, including prominent public areas such as Nowingi Place, the Water Play Park and the Off Leash Dog Park, were also impacted.

Nowingi Place, the Off Leash Dog Park and Apex Park are in the process of reopening to the public, with the majority of affected local roads also assessed and reopened.

This includes roads in Nichols Point, Etiwanda Avenue leading to Baldwin Boats, Karadoc Avenue leading to the Nichols Point Cemetery and several unsealed roads in Nangiloc and Colignan.

Work, meanwhile, is continuing in the recovery space, with Council staff completing secondary impacted assessments for more than 30 private residences and 27 commercial properties which were inundated by flood water.

A series of free kerbside collections for flood-affected properties has also taken place.

Creating a more connected Council

A landmark internal realignment of our organisational structure, is set to deliver a more connected and customer-focused Mildura Rural City Council.

The Organisational Sustainability Review (OSR) is the largest review undertaken by Council in decades and is set to position Council to meet the challenges and grasp the opportunities that come now and in the future.

One of the biggest changes flagged is the introduction of a fourth department – 'Strategy & Growth' – and a realignment of the other three departments.

The new Strategy and Growth area of Council will play a critical role in ensuring the organisation and the

community are ready for any opportunities that present themselves.

It will align functions such as arts, tourism, events, land use and major projects, further supporting local businesses to grow and develop.

The review of Mildura Rural City Council's current management structure recommended several key changes, with reducing staff-to-manager ratios highlighted as an important mechanism to increase productivity and improve customer experience when interacting with Council.

A nation-wide competitive search to fill Council's vital General Manager positions is also underway, with successful applicants to lead each of the four departments and support Council's endeavours to improve services.

CBD Revitalisation Project enters an exciting phase

Mildura Rural City Council is moving ahead with plans to revitalise and transform the region's Central Business District.

The CBD Revitalisation Project is about to enter its next phase following community consultation on three proposed concepts for a revamped Feast Street, and 10 placemaking ideas for the Langtree Mall.

More than 160 public submissions were received regarding these ideas and concepts, with the key themes identified including parking availability, support for more outdoor dining spaces, accessibility for the elderly and disabled, and ensuring the CBD becomes a greener space.

Work is now progressing to develop an overall streetscape design for Feast Street, alongside other investment priorities and future opportunities for Langtree Mall and the wider CBD.

New and expanded kindergarten opens to the public

Work to extend and upgrade the Irymple Kindergarten is complete, thanks to a \$952,500 grant from the Department of Education and Training's Building Blocks Program.

The extension represents the first major works undertaken at the kindergarten since 2011, and will allow more space for three-year-old kinder programs to be offered to meet the increasing demands in the growing lrymple area.

The extension has also transformed the Irymple Kindergarten into the largest in regional Victoria, with 198 children enrolled for 2023.

The works, which started in 2022 and were completed earlier this year, has delivered new playrooms, bathroom facilities and administration area.

Air conditioning and heating units have also been updated.

Local contractors, Wilkie Building Contractors, delivered the works in collaboration with Mildura Rural City Council acting as project managers.

The new-look Irymple Kindergarten was unveiled to the local community during an Open Day in March 2023.

A recipient of the 2022 Victorian Young Achiever of the Year Award in the 'Connecting Communities' category, Conor was a member of Mildura's 2021 Youth Parliament, which created a bill to Criminalise Coercive Control in intimate partner relationships. He is also the only Mallee resident currently serving as a Young Peer Facilitator for the Victorian Youth Affairs Council.

Community Event or Project of the Year - JOINT WINNERS

Red Cliffs Centenary Committee - 2022 Red Cliffs Centenary Celebrations and North West Victorian Motorcycle Club - 2022 Hattah Desert Race

The 2022 Red Cliffs Centenary Celebrations was a four-day event held in April 2022, attracting people from across Australia to mark a century since the township was established as a soldier-settlement. The event brought former and current residents together to celebrate the town's growth over the past century, while also re-connecting the township following the COVID-19 pandemic.

The Hattah Desert Race marked its 25th year in 2022 and remains the only motorcycle event of its type in Australia to offer a junior component. The 2022 event was made possible thanks to more than 20,000 volunteer hours, with more than 7,000 people attending, helping to inject an estimated \$5million into the local economy.

Families with children aged four years and under are invited to take part in fun sessions that include crafts, puzzles, toys, stories, songs and much more!


Children can play, learn and practice social skills, while parents have the support of a facilitator to make the most of learning opportunities.
