Have your say on Revenue
and Rating Plan

Council is undertaking a review of its
Revenue and Rating Plan and is seeking
community feedback.

The Revenue and Rating Plan must be
reviewed by the elected Council following
the local government elections (every four
years), with the updated version to be in
effect by June 2023.

Council is considering two options:

- Leaving the differential rates
unchanged
- Increasing the share of income raised
from business and farming differential
rates. This will in turn reduce the share
residential properties contribute to
rates.

The purpose of this review is to determine
the percentage of rates collected through
each of the different property types in our
municipality – not the total value of
rates generated.
