Stories will be publicly launched at an event on Indigenous Literacy Day on 6 September.

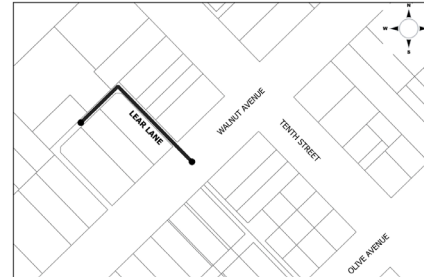
### Geographic Naming Proposal - Lear Lane

- Lear Lane

William Thomas John "Jack" Lear was born 29 October 1883. Jack served in the Australian Imperial Forces (AIF) from February 1915 to July 1919. Jack's first

posting was with the Mediterranean Expeditionary Force (MEF) in Gallipoli, where in August 1915, the Allies launched a major offensive in an attempt to break the deadlock that ensued, following the invasion of Gallipoli on 25 April 1915.
