### Planning and Environment Act 1987 - Notice of Approval of Amendment C123mild

Heritage Precincts Technical Correction

The Minister for Planning has approved Amendment C123mild to the Mildura Planning Scheme.

The Amendment came into operation on 8 June 2023 via the notice published in the Victoria Government Gazette.

The Amendment replaces Clause 15.03-1L (Heritage conservation in Mildura) with a new Clause 15.03-1L to insert strategies for Chaffey heritage in the Chaffey Avenue and Environs Area (HO307), Deakin Avenue (HO308) and Lemon Avenue (HO309) into the Planning Policy Framework.
