Aged Care services update – June 2023

Council is in the final stages of transitioning Commonwealth Home Support Programme (CHSP) services to new providers.

New CHSP providers will commence service provision from 1 July 2023.

Due to the large number of people transitioning, those receiving Personal Care and Flexible Respite will be contacted as a priority, followed by those receiving other service types including Domestic Assistance and Property Maintenance. It is expected that some customers may not be contacted by their new provider until mid-July. To prepare for a possible gap in service provision we recommend that customers talk to their support network and make a plan, especially for Domestic Assistance services.
