Council is currently seeking feedback on its Draft Recreation Facilities Pricing Policy.

The policy has been developed in consultation with local user groups and key stakeholders and is now available for review.

The policy aims to provide guidance and an overarching framework regarding pricing of Council owned or managed recreation facilities.

It aims to ensure a consistent approach to the pricing of such facilities, while ensuring users of recreation facilities understand what they are paying for, why they are paying and are confident that other user groups in similar situations are also contributing in a consistent manner.

Change to traffic conditions – Dyar Avenue

Motorists traveling along Dyar Avenue near The Lake Primary School are being advised of changed traffic conditions to improve safety.

A new 40km/h School Zone is now in effect during school pick-up and drop-off times, while the regularly posted speed limit has been reduced to 60km/h for a 750m stretch of Dyar Avenue from Seventeenth Street.

The remaining section of Dyar Avenue will retain a posted speed limit of 80km/h.

Mildura Rural City Council has been working with the Department of Transport and Planning to facilitate the changes, while also working closely with The Lake Primary School and local community groups on other safety projects.

This includes establishing a path on Seventeenth Street from McEdward Street to Brindabella Estate and widening Dyar Avenue.

Further works are being considered as part of Council's 2023/24 Capital Works Program, and include building a footpath linking the Lake Hawthorn walking Track from Dyar Avenue to the school and constructing a footpath on Dyar Avenue. These works are also subject to external funding.
