Tree removals – Mildura Riverfront Skate Park

Due to recent acts of vandalism, and structural concerns, we're being forced to remove two large peppercorn trees adjacent to the Mildura Riverfront Skate Park.

These trees will be removed from Monday 4 September, with our team hoping to complete works by Thursday 7 September. There will be NO access to the nearby area or the skate park while these works are carried out.

Removal of trees is always a last resort for Mildura Rural City Council, however, after a thorough examination of the trees by both Council arborists and a consulting arborist, it was agreed that we have no option but to remove these trees due to the potential risk they pose.

These trees have no specific significance or relevance to this area, nor are they native to this area. Numerous trees have already been planted to offset these removals.
