Notice of Approval of Amendment C118mild

Mildura Older Irrigation Area Incorporated Document (Oct 2023)

The Minister for Planning has approved Amendment C118mild to the Mildura Planning Scheme.

The Amendment comes into operation on 23 November 2023 as published in the Victoria Government Gazette.

The Amendment replaces the Mildura Older Irrigation Area Incorporated Document (May 2020) with the Mildura Older Irrigation Area Incorporated Document (October 2023) to delete the requirement that a dwelling abutting existing development must not be located in a designated bushfire prone area. The Amendment also makes administrative changes to Schedules 1,2 and 4 to Clause 35.06 (Rural Conservation Zone) and the Schedule to Clause 35.07 (Farming Zone).

Shingles vaccinations The Shingrix (shingles) vaccine is available free-of-charge for eligible people most at risk of complications from shingles.

A two-dose course of Shingrix is available for free for people aged 65 years and over, First Nations people aged 50 years and over, and immunocompromised people adults with eligible medical conditions.

Conditions apply for those who have previously received a shingles vaccine. There is a limited supply of the vaccine. Bookings are essential.
