Our Strategic Planning will be at Powerhouse Place on the following dates to discuss the Urban Forest Strategy and collect feedback.

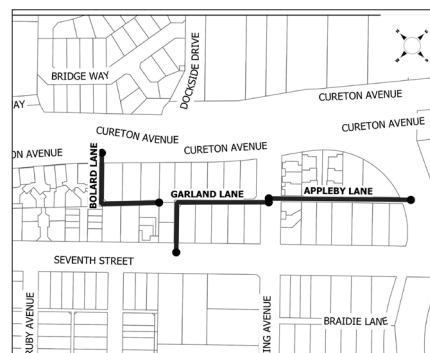
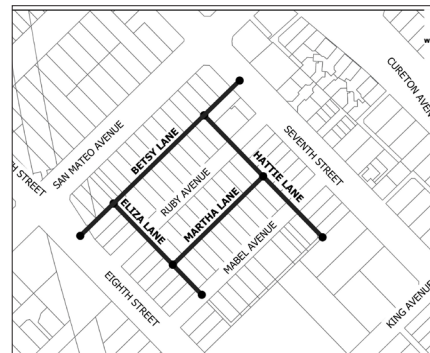
