Notice of the preparation of an

amendment to a planning scheme

Amendment C121mild

The amendment has been prepared by Mildura Rural City Council, which is the planning authority for this amendment.

The amendment has been made at the request of the landowner.

The amendment applies to land at 13 Dal Farra Road, Irymple, being Lot 1 TP674265 and Lot 1 TP232429.

The amendment proposes to:

- Rezone the land from the Farming Zone (FZ) to the Low Density Residential Zone, Schedule 1 (LDRZ1) to facilitate its use for low density residential development.
- Apply the Design and Development Overlay, Schedule 16 (DDO16 – 13 Dal Farra Road, Irymple) to the land.
- Apply the Development Plan Overlay, Schedule 2 (DPO2 – Low Density Residential Areas) to the land.
- Apply the Salinity Management Overlay (SMO) to the land.
- Insert a new Schedule 16 to the Design and Development Overlay (DDO16) into the planning scheme.
- Amend the Schedule to Clause 66.06 (Notice of permit applications under local provisions) to require notice of applications under the DDO16 to the Department of Energy, Environment and Climate Action.

Name and contact details of submitters are required for the planning authority to consider submissions and to notify such persons of the opportunity to attend planning authority meetings and any public hearing held to consider submissions.
