Feedback sought on MEGA Strategic Framework Plan

Development of the Mildura East Growth Area (MEGA) Strategic Framework is entering its next exciting stage, with Mildura Rural City Council seeking feedback on both the MEGA Framework Plan, and a Stormwater Management Strategy for the study area.

The Mildura East Framework Plan sets objectives and actions that will shape how land identified in Phase 2 (Vision & Key Directions Report 2022) for future residential and larger lifestyle lots between Mildura, Irymple and Nichols Point will develop.

A Stormwater Management Strategy has now been finalised for the MEGA and is on exhibition with the draft Framework Plan.

2024 Mildura Planning Scheme Review

Round 1 Community Engagement Council has appointed a consultant team led by Plan2Place to undertake the 2024 Mildura Planning Scheme Review.

The Mildura Planning Scheme is a statutory document that controls how land is used and developed within the Mildura municipality. It also helps preserve the things we love about our region. A planning scheme review is a requirement of the Planning and Environment Act 1987 and is to be undertaken by Council every four years.

The aim of the review is to assess how the Mildura Planning Scheme is performing and outline a plan to implement changes to respond to identified gaps. This will ensure the planning scheme remains up to date and responsive to changing circumstances, including shifts in government policy, community aspirations, and land use issues and trends.

Plan2Place and Council officers will be conducting in-person community consultation on the following dates:

Planning officers and the consultant will be available to speak to about the review and how you can be involved. We are keen to hear about your experience living in Mildura and what you would like to see in the future for the municipality.

Your comments will be collected, collated and themed to form part of a short report that identifies key issues for the project to consider and respond to.
