This meeting is open for the public to attend in person. Please note that this meeting may become virtual with limited notice in accordance with sub-rule 18 (b) of the Governance Rules.

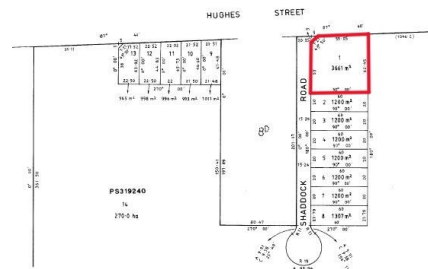
