### Battery Recycling options available at Council sites

Mildura Rural City Council is partnering with Australian company EcoBatt to help locals recycle unwanted batteries safely.

Large household and power tool battery collections will be located at:

- Mildura Landfill
- Ouyen Landfill/Transfer Station

Eligible items include: AA batteries, AAA batteries, Button Batteries, 9V batteries, Power tool batteries, C & D size batteries, Lithium-Ion batteries (up to 5kg) and mobile phones.

Smaller household collections will be located at:

- Madden Service Centre
- Deakin Service Centre
- Ouyen Service Centre
- Red Cliffs Library
- Merbein Library
- Murrayville Library

Eligible items include: AA batteries, AAA batteries, Button Batteries, 9V batteries, C & D size batteries, Lithium-Ion batteries (up to 5kg) and small power tools.

All battery terminals must be taped before disposal to reduce the risk of accidental fires. Please inform staff if batteries are damaged or swollen.
