Have Your Say - Draft Irymple Low Density Residential Development Plan

The Draft Irymple Low Density Residential Development Plan is now available for comment. The plan seeks to:

- Create a low-density urban environment compatible with the Mildura-Irymple Urban Transition Area strategy.
- Optimise land development for low density residential lots in the study area
- Provide an appropriate level of low density residential growth on serviced lots.
- Establish a connected neighbourhood structure including safe access for pedestrians, cyclists and motorists
- Provide access to public open space for residents.
- Create a public realm suited to Irymple's low-density residential and Urban Transition Areas.
- Establish appropriate drainage reserves to service the area.
