Proposed speed limit change - Red Cliffs

Council is considering asking the Department of Transport and Planning (DTP) to reduce speed limits along Indi Avenue and Cocklin Avenue in Red Cliffs following community concern about road safety.

We're proposing the following changes:
• Existing 60km/h limit to be changed to 50km/h on Indi Avenue
• Existing 100km/h limit to be changed to 60km/h on Cocklin Avenue

These changes will also ensure consistency of speed limits across our road network. We want to hear from local residents, road users and the wider community about the proposed speed limit change.
