Mildura Planning Scheme - Notice of Approval of Amendment
Amendment C116mild – 174 Cootamundra Avenue, Red Cliffs

The Minister for Planning has approved Amendment C116mild to the Mildura Planning Scheme.

The Amendment took effect on 23 October 2025, as published in the Victoria Government Gazette.

The Amendment rezones land at 174 Cootamundra Avenue, Red Cliffs and part of the adjacent road reservation from Public Conservation and Resource Zone (PCRZ) to Farming Zone (FZ).
