Come and explore the new Red Cliffs Early Years Hub, visit the Sunraysia Toy Library, and enjoy a FREE barbecue and children's activities.

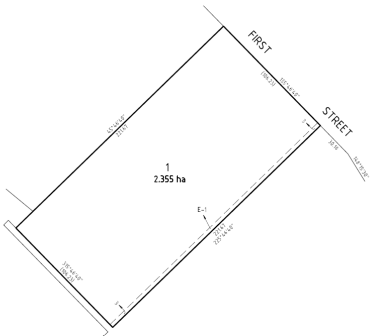
The day will include a Welcome to Country and community welcome from 10:30am.

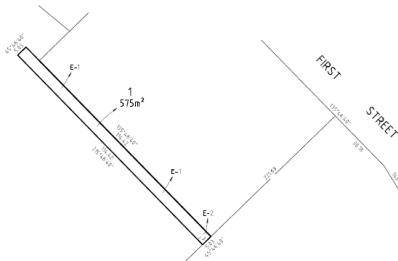
