### MMR vaccination: Are you protected?

Measles cases are on the rise in Victoria, with significantly more infections reported over the past year. Measles spread easily and can cause serious complications, especially for people who are unvaccinated.

Measles protection requires two doses of the measles-mumps-rubella (MMR) vaccine. If you're unsure whether you've had both doses, it's important to get vaccinated.

People aged 20 to 60 are eligible for a free state-funded MMR vaccine (no Medicare card required). These vaccinations can be booked online at [mildura.vic.gov.au/Immunisation](http://mildura.vic.gov.au/Immunisation)
