





The location

Mildura has a long history of hosting events of all sizes in our region. The Mediterranean climate and riverside location Mildura enjoys provides the perfect backdrop for your event. Our beautiful city boasts almost year-round sunshine, coupled with a diverse array of accommodation, venue and hospitality options. Mildura Rural City Council has supported events to the region for more than 20 years. Annually, a number of organisations visit Mildura for their event.

With the backdrop of the Murray River, there are few better locations or facilities of this significance in our community. Nowingi Place is a multi-purpose venue that can be used for small scale performances, concerts, community and other events such as Mildura Carols by Candlelight or large events such as the Triple J One Night Stand held in 2014.

Conveniently located near the border of three states, an hour's flight from two major metropolitan centres and enjoying full suite of services and venues close by, Mildura is the perfect location for your event. Mildura is also supported will with significant interest and patronage by the communities surrounding our regional city such as Broken Hill, Renmark and the Riverland, Balranald and towns along the Mallee Track.



Nowingi Place

The venue includes a 12m x 10m stage, back-of-house facilities including toilets, storage and performer's facilities and space for up to 4,250 seated patrons and up to 15,000 in total. More than 600 parking spaces are also available around the venue. The Nowingi Place site boasts in excess of 50,000 square meters of manicured lawns and parkland.

Nowingi Place - Technical Information

Stage

The stage surface is concrete

Width 12mtrs

Depth 10mtrs

Height 1mtr

Carpet for stage – 66 x 1m squares (48 black, 18 red)

Risers – two 1m x 2m risers with 500mm legs

Audio and Audio Power Patching

Front Control Position

24 send, 8 return multi-core 25 metres from stage (tails stored in control room)

12 send, 4 return multi-core 25 metres from stage (tails stored in control room)

1 x 15amp audio power outlet

2 x 10amp GPO

4 x composite video (two to each side of stage)

2 x cat5 (one to each side of stage)

1 x DMX to control room

Stage

Audio distribution from control room to stage - 5 x 12 channel audio multi-core comprising 8 sends and 4 returns in trapdoors located around stage (tails stored in control room)

2 x 15amp audio power outlets in trapdoor stage front left and stage rear (total of 4)

1 x 15amp audio power outlet in trapdoor stage front right

1 x 15amp audio power outlet on each front side under stage (total of 2)

1 x double 10amp GPO on each side of front stage underneath

1 x double 10amp GPO at each side of rear stage underneath

Lighting

Lighting Control Desk: LSC Maxim M 24 channel DMX512

Dimmer: LSC iPak 12 channel DMX512

No in-house lighting fixtures are supplied other than 4 stage floodlights which are controllable via 4 faders in the control room or via DMX on channels 13-16

3 Phase Power

1 x 32amp 3 phase outlet on each side of stage rear

This is in addition to the 3 phase hard-wired to the 12 channel house dimmer in the control room

Lighting Patching

Stage rear – 6 x 240V patch points on rear stage bar

Front – 6 x 240V patch points on each side of front towers

All 18 240V patch-points terminate in the rear stage control room where the 12 channel dimmer is located.

One DMX patch point from control position 25 metres from stage to control room. DMX distributed via splitter from control room to both front sides of stage and on rear lighting bar

Event Medical Services

In your best interests, Mildura Rural City Council will require proof that an appropriate level of First Aid is provided at an event. Event Organisers have a duty of care to patrons and staff to ensure that risks are appropriately managed and that professional First Aid is available onsite to cover the unexpected. Accidents can happen irrespective of the size of the event, and having event medical services ready to respond will ensure peace of mind.
