Welcome to your Library

You can access a wide range of library materials and online resources. We have services, programs and community spaces for everyone.

Membership is FREE

Visit any of our libraries and bring current identification that shows your name and residential address. Children and young people under 18 require a parent or legal guardian to join.

- Borrow up to 20 items
- Your checkout receipt shows item due dates
- Books and audiobooks for four (4) weeks; All other items for two (2) weeks
- Automatic renewals may occur once
- Receive notifications by email or SMS for holds or overdue items
- 24-hour return chutes at Merbein, Mildura, Ouyen and Red Cliffs
- Charges will apply for items that are lost or have been damaged
- A PIN will give you access to eLibrary and online resources
- Young people under 12 must be actively supervised in the library
- Please notify staff of change of name, address or loss of membership card

Memberships are available for neighbouring municipalities, visitors, eLibrary access, teachers and education providers. Please speak to staff for more information.

Please bring your library card, physical or digital, when borrowing. You are responsible for the care and return of items borrowed on your card. Please report damaged or faulty items to staff.

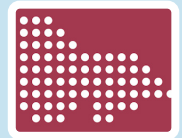

Libraries Victoria - *review your account, place holds and more*

Select 'My Account' and enter your Borrower Number (Library card number) and press 'OK'. Add in your PIN and press 'login'. To add family members' library cards, select 'My Account' and choose 'linked Accounts' and then 'Add'.



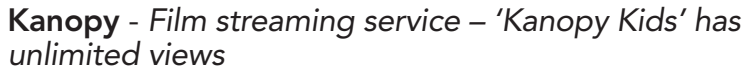
BorrowBox - *eBooks, audiobooks and ePress magazines*

Library – search for 'Mildura Library' and enter your User ID (Library card number) and PIN. Agree to the terms and conditions, provide an email address and your first name.

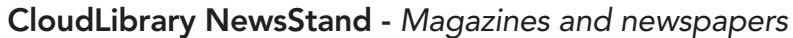


uLIBRARY - *eBooks and audiobooks*

Library – search for 'Mildura Rural City Council Libraries' and enter your 'Barcode Number' (Library card number) and PIN and 'sign in'. 'Accept' the terms and conditions, and select 'eAudiobooks' or 'eBooks' to start browsing and reading. Choose 'More' if you would like to enter your email address for notifications.



Tap 'Get Started' and search for 'Mildura' and choose 'Full Library' collection. Enter your library card number and tap 'Login'.



Tap 'New user? Please register online' at the bottom of the screen. Fill in the registration, accept the terms and tap 'Next'. Choose your country and library (Mildura Rural City Council Libraries), type your library card number and PIN and tap 'Register'. Log in with your email address and password you just created.

Children's programs at our Libraries

Our programs for children include Baby Play and Storytime. We have school holiday and afterschool sessions for young people.

- Baby Play is aimed at children 0 to 12 months
- Storytime is aimed at preschool aged children
- Holiday and afterschool sessions are for children attending primary school

Young people under 12 must be actively supervised in the library.



Computer access and printing

Our libraries offer free access to computers with Microsoft Office software and Internet for document creation, downloading, scanning and emailing. Charges apply for printing, copying or faxing.

If you have your own laptop, smartphone or tablet, 'Council Free Wi-Fi' is available.

Meeting Room Hire

Rooms suitable for meetings, small workshops or group training are available for hire. Rooms are available at Merbein, Mildura, Ouyen and Red Cliffs Libraries.

To view full conditions of use or to download a booking form, visit our website 'Library Services' and 'Meeting Rooms'.

The Meeting Booth at the Mildura Library is a quiet space for one or two adults for work, study, online interviews or appointments. Bookings are available for two hours per day, free of charge.



Local and Family History

Our local history collection includes unique books, documents, newspapers and online images. View our local newspaper archive dating back to 1888 at Mildura Library using the microform reader/printer. Early local newspapers are also available on the TROVE website.

Preservation Station

Do you have precious photos, film or documents you want to save? Turn them into digital copies for free using our self-serve Preservation Station. Bookings required, contact library staff for more information or our website under 'Library Services' and 'Preservation Station'.

Book Club Sets

Book Club sets are available for an annual fee. Form your own book club of up to 12 people – your group may like to meet in members' homes, at coffee shops or in your local library.



Home Library Service

Home Library Service offers free monthly delivery of a personalised selection of materials to local residents who have difficulty visiting the library for health or mobility reasons. Home Library is also available to residents of care facilities.
