

SIGNING GUIDELINES

- 1. GENERALLY SIGN LOCATION IS TO BE ON LEFT-HAND (INWARDS) CORNER OF THE TURN FROM MAJOR ROAD TO MINOR ROAD. REFER TO FIGURE 1.
- 2. WHERE POSSIBLE SIGN IS TO BE APPROXIMATELY LOCATED AT THE INTERSECTION OF CENTRELINES OF THE TWO NATURESTRIPS (OR VERGES). REFER TO FIGURE 5, PREFERRED OPTION (1)
- 3. WHERE THE ABOVE IS UNATTAINABLE SIGN IS TO BE LOCATED AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE PROPERTY LINE AND NATURESTRIP CENTRELINE OF EITHER ROAD. REFER FIGURE 5, PREFERRED OPTION ②,③ THE SIGN CAN BE PLACED AT THE HEAD OF THE 'T' IF APPROPRIATE. IN THIS INSTANCE ONE SIGN IS TO POINT TOWARDS INTERSECTION. ④
- 4. FINGERBOARDS ARE TO POINT AWAY FROM INTERSECTION, AVOIDING OVERHANG BEYOND KERB ALIGNMENT.
- 5. FINGERBOARDS TO PROVIDE CLEARANCE OF:
 - (i) 300mm MIN. TO EDGE OF FOOTPATH, OR
 - (ii) 600mm MIN. TO EDGE OF SHOULDER OR GUIDE POST LINE.
- 6. DESIRABLY THERE SHOULD BE NO MORE THAN 3 FINGERBOARDS PER SIGNPOST.
- 7. FINAL LOCATION TO BE CHECKED FOR EXISTING SERVICES PRIOR TO COMMENCEMENT OF WORK.
- 8. TWO SIGN INSTALLATION SHOULD BE USED FOR DIVIDED CARRIAGEWAY SITUATIONS IN ACCORDANCE WITH ABOVE GUIDELINES (REFER FIGURE 2).
- 9. STREET NAME SIGN OF 'THE MAJOR ROAD' SHALL BE THE UPPERMOST FINGERBOARD.
- 10. USE 'NO THRU ROAD' OVERLAY IN RED COLOUR WHERE APPROPRIATE.
