### Tree Pruning in Mildura and Red Cliffs for Power Line Clearance

Council will be undertaking tree pruning around power lines in Mildura and Red Cliffs over the coming weeks, subject to weather conditions. Council will start works no earlier than 14 days from time of notification.

Council is required to maintain vegetation clearance around power lines in compliance with the Electricity Safety (Electric Line Clearance) Regulations 2020 (Vic) and the Code of Practice for Electric Line Clearance set out in the Schedule to the Regulations.

Notice is hereby given by Mildura Rural City Council, pursuant to Clause 5 of the Code, of pruning works on trees which may be on council nature strips, council owned land and/or within the boundaries of council owned and maintained properties in the Mildura and Red Cliffs townships.
